- Develop an entrepreneurial mindset by pursuing a <u>Certificate in Entrepreneurship</u> <u>& Technology</u> offered through Sutardja Center or the <u>Berkeley Certificate in</u> <u>Design Innovation</u> from the Jacobs Institute.
- Learn from tech entrepreneurs (most of them Cal alumni) in the one-unit <u>Newton</u> <u>Lecture Series: A Berkeley Changemaker Course</u> or take a ten-week course in entrepreneurship via <u>StEP</u>.

Find opportunities beyond coursework: Explore entrepreneurial scholarships and fellowships in the <u>Discovery Opportunities Database</u>, including opportunities to:

- Get mentorship for fostering and scaling ideas in the **Fung Fellowship** or **Free Ventures Fellowship**.
- Intern with startups through the <u>SkyDeck Ace Intern Program</u> or the <u>UCB Startup</u> <u>Fair</u>.
- Secure funding for a prototype with the <u>Jacobs Innovation Catalyst Grant</u> or startup venture through the **Berkeley Haas Entrepreneurship Startup Seed Fund**
- Participate in weekend <u>hackathons</u> or compete in the <u>Collider Cup</u> or <u>Big Ideas</u> <u>Contest</u>.
